Problem

The client had a roof that had reached the end of its useful life. The existing roof coverings were failing and there was insufficient insulation. The existing 4 glass rooflights were also suffering from UV degradation and leaking.

Solution

Higham Roofing in conjunction with their partner suppliers were called in to provide a long term solution to the problem and also provide 4 new triple skin insulated rooflights. Working closely with our client and suppliers we provided a 25 year insurance backed specification. And also provided a specification to replace the existing glass roof lights with double skin insulated polycarbonate rooflights.

Higham Roofing were awarded the contract and successfully project managed the entire project. This involved stripping the existing roof coverings down to the deck. We Then installed a new torch applied underlay and 5mm thick mineral surfaced cap sheet to all areas. All the abutments to walls received code 4 lead flashings.
